## H. New Business – Jo Ellen (Hugs Across the Country)

Jo Ellen gave a presentation regarding Hugs Across the Country and their needs in this area. She also explained what they do for the children in our community. Their grants are getting ready to expire and they will need financial support to feed all children in our community. They provide lunches at schools for kids in need, our school has about 100 students that receive this assistance. They also provide bags for kids needing food over the weekend. Clothing is also available for these children. It was said that these students are identified by school counselors. JoEllen asked that the PTO assist financially in helping pay for food/snacks for these students.

Carla said that she didn't agree. She felt that wasn't the function of the PTO to provide financial assistance to buy food for students. Principal Brown said that all students in need at our school are fed in the cafeteria and he didn't think that was an issue, but would check on it. Other board members said that they felt this was also a school issue that needed to be investigated. The reduced lunch program was

discussed. It was explained that parents are responsible for completing the paperwork for that and they may not want people to know they are in need.
